


# Powerful Winter Storm This Weekend



Winter Storm Watch (Saturday morning – Sunday afternoon)

Lakeshore Flood Warning (Saturday afternoon – Sunday afternoon)

#### Message of the Day:



- A prolonged period of heavy snow is expected from early Saturday morning through early Sunday afternoon. Widespread 10+ inch accumulations expected.
- Blizzard conditions expected along the North Shore.
- Lakeshore flooding expected near the Twin Ports area.
- Freezing drizzle possible late Friday night and early Saturday.

# **Powerful Thanksgiving Weekend Winter Storm**

### **Key Points**

#### Hazards:

- Widespread snow accumulations of 10 inches or more are likely
- One to two inch per hour snowfall rates are possible Saturday afternoon through early Sunday
- Blowing and drifting snow is expected along the North Shore, where blizzard conditions and 20+" of snow are possible
- Lakeshore flooding is expected near Duluth and Superior
- A light glaze of ice is also possible due to freezing drizzle late Friday night and early Saturday



Areas Impacted: All of northeast Minnesota and northwest Wisconsin



**Timing & Duration:** Snow is forecast to move into the Northland late tonight into Saturday morning. Snow will then continue through Sunday morning. Lakeshore flooding is most likely Saturday afternoon through Sunday afternoon.



**Impacts:** Travel will become dangerous, if not impossible, particularly near Duluth north along the North Shore on Highway 61 Saturday into Sunday. Power outages are likely.



**Certainty & Considerations:** Confidence in 10"+ is fairly high across much of the Northland. Confidence in blizzard conditions along the North Shore to include the City of Duluth is also high.



**Historical Perspective:** This has the potential for a top-10 highest two-day snowfall total in recorded history for Duluth, with top-15 for Ashland and Brainerd.




# **Lakeshore Flooding Expected**



- Waves of 10 to 18 feet will crash on the shores of Lake Superior, which could produce flooding and damage along the lake shore
- Stay off break walls and other shoreline structures or you could be swept away!
- Winds/waves will gradually diminish Sunday afternoon

# **Powerful Thanksgiving Weekend Winter Storm**

#### Winter Hazard Definitions

- A **Blizzard Warning** is issued when the combination of strong wind, low visibility, and heavy snow will significantly impact the area. <u>Avoid traveling if possible! Time to act!</u>
- A Winter Storm Warning is issued when heavy snow or a combination of heavy snow, blowing snow, and ice is expected to impact the area. <u>Avoid</u> <u>traveling if possible! Be sure to have a winter driving safety kit!</u>
- A Lakeshore Flood Warning is issued when flooding is occurring or expected along the lake. <u>Residents should take appropriate action to protect</u> <u>life and property!</u>

## **Winter Weather Preparedness**

- Winterize your car, and be sure to include a winter driving safety kit!
- Restock your emergency kit at home with batteries, food, water, etc.
- If you have a generator, make sure
  it is working and NEVER run a
  generator in an enclosed space like
  a garage!
