


Winter Storm Tonight & Tomorrow



Message of the Day:



- Widespread snow, heavy at times, is expected tonight through Monday.
- Snow accumulation of 3 to 8 inches in the advisory area and 5 to 11 in the warning area.
- Snow will affect the Monday morning commute.

Winter Storm Tonight & Tomorrow Key Points



Hazards: Snow, heavy at times.



Areas Impacted: Most of central, north-central, and northeast Minnesota. All of northwest Wisconsin.



Timing & Duration: Snow begins tonight in central Minnesota and overspreads the remainder of the Northland by sunrise Monday morning. A brief period of lake effect snow is possible this evening along the South Shore. The snow will affect the Monday morning commute.



Impacts: Roads will become snow-covered and slippery. Visibility will be reduced. Heavy snow and strong winds along the South Shore may lead to isolated power outages.




Certainty & Considerations: Additional areas may need to be added to the warning with later updates. Confidence in snow totals in the advisory area is high. Confidence in the warning area is medium-high. Snow totals in Douglas, Bayfield, Ashland, and Iron counties may need to be enhanced due to lake effect snow. We are confident in at least 8 inches of snow for those areas.

Winter Hazard Definitions

- A Winter Storm Warning is issued when heavy snow or a combination of heavy snow, blowing snow, and ice is expected to impact the area. <u>Avoid</u> <u>traveling if possible! *Time to act!*</u>
- A **Winter Weather Advisory** is issued when snow or a combination of snow, blowing snow, and some ice is expected to impact the area. <u>Use caution while traveling!</u>

Winter Weather Preparedness

- Winterize your car, and be sure to include a winter driving safety kit!
- Restock your emergency kit at home with batteries, food, water, etc.
- If you have a generator, make sure it is working – and NEVER run a generator in an enclosed space like a garage!
