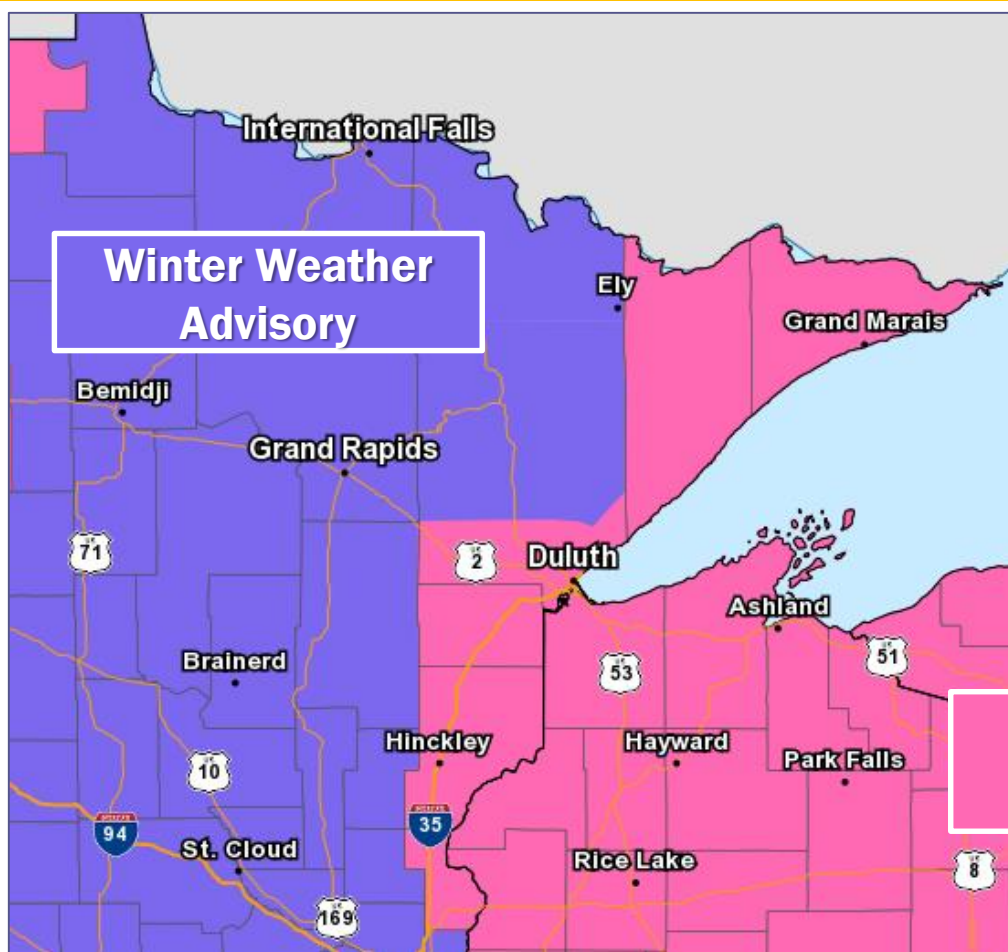




Winter Storm Continues Today



Message of the Day:

- Winter storm continues today with a light wintry mix this morning changing to snow this afternoon, periods of heavy snow possible late afternoon into tonight causing difficult travel conditions during the evening commute
- Gusty winds and the light-and-fluffy nature of this round of snow today may cause areas of blowing snow.
- Falling temperatures will cause wet surfaces to become icy!







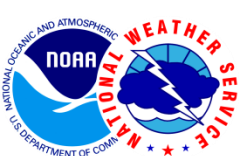
Forecast snowfall amounts have been lowered.

Winter Storm Continues Today

Key Points

<p>Hazards</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Heavy Snow ➤ Blowing Snow ➤ Rapidly falling temperatures causing surfaces to become icy
<p>Areas Impacted</p> 	<p>All of northeast MN & northwest WI, but highest snowfall amounts along south shore</p>
<p>Timing</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Wintry mix to snow develops this morning ➤ Snow, heavy at times afternoon/evening along with rapidly falling temperatures causing surfaces to freeze ➤ Snow ends from west to east this evening
<p>Impacts</p> 	<p>Roads becoming snow-covered and icy <i>(Even where little snow is expected, rapidly falling temperatures will cause roads, sidewalks, driveways, etc. to become icy!)</i></p>
<p>Certainty</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ High confidence on falling temperatures ➤ Some uncertainty still with regards to the possibility for heavy snowfall rates during the evening commute for north shore and Twin Ports, but high confidence remains for snowfall amounts for the south shore

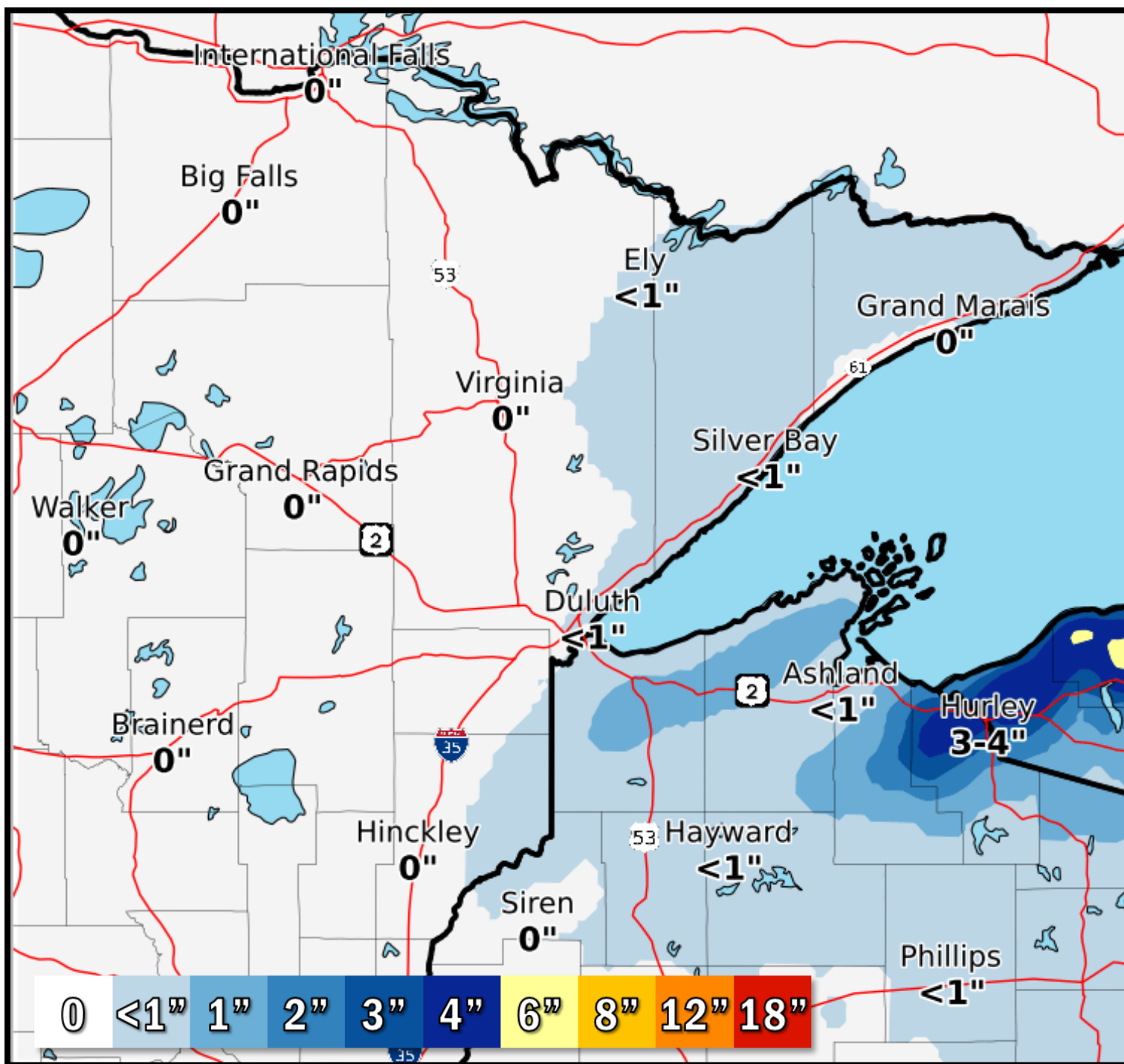

Monday 6 AM → Tuesday 12 PM



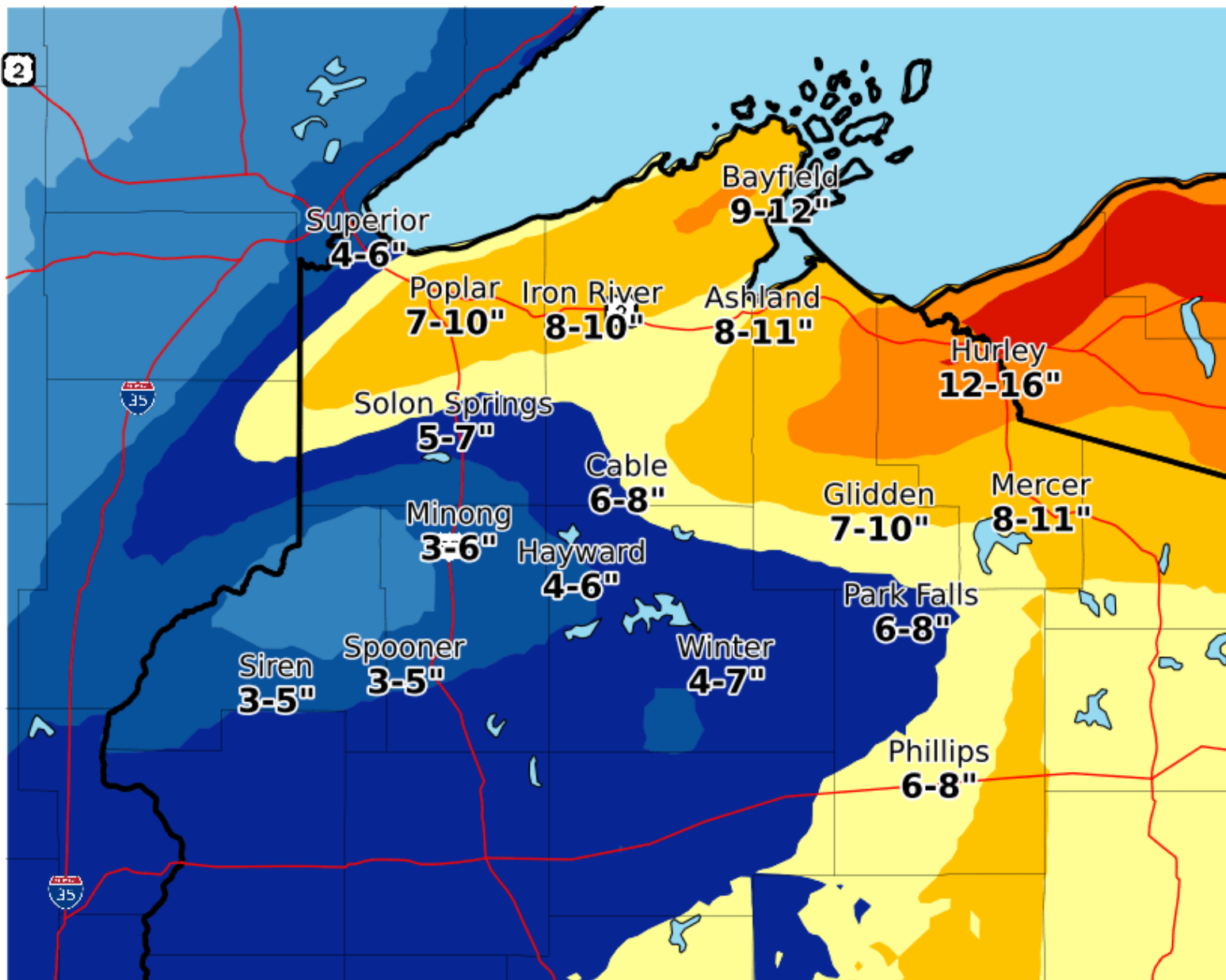


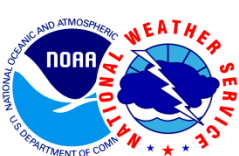

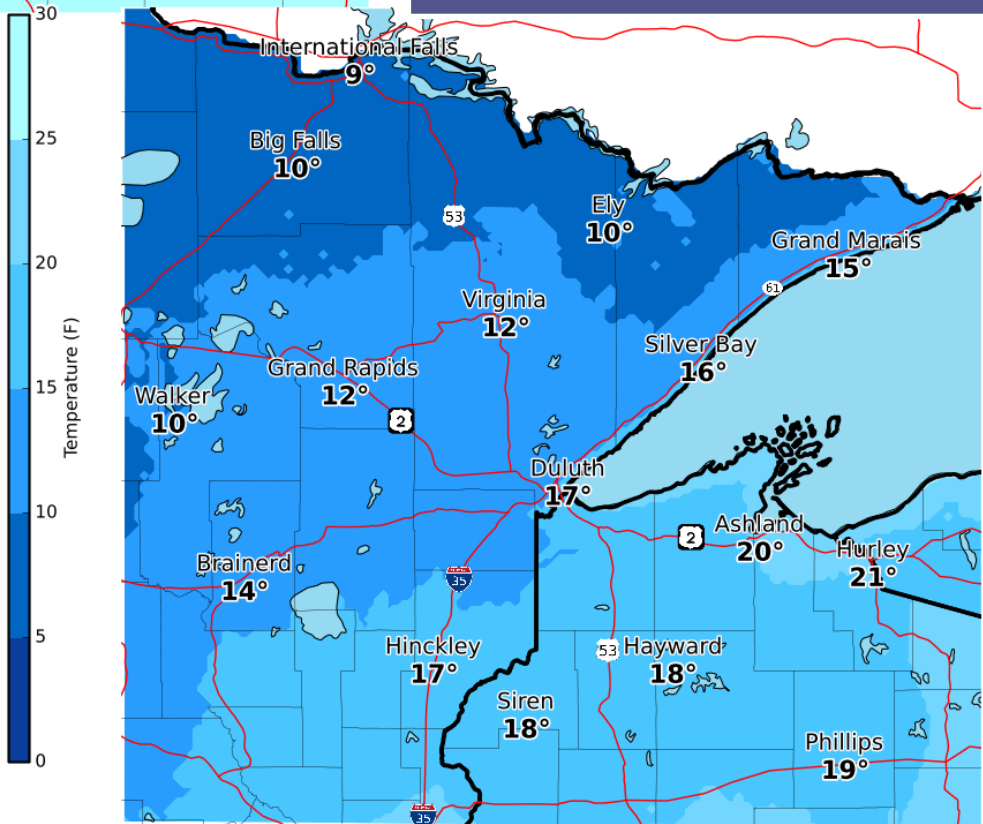

Winter Driving Safety

- Clear snow and ice from windows and lights
- Brake early. Leave twice the amount of room for stopping.
- Don't use cruise control in wintry conditions
- Don't cut in front of other vehicles
- Take it slow! Delay travel if feasible.
