Dear Families,

The Siren School District has been informed by the county health department that there are 2 confirmed COVID-19 cases with individuals in the high school.

As a result, we have closed the high school from Monday, September 21 through October 2, 2020 for in-person learning. High school students will be continuing their education virtually with remote learning. This closure will include all activities, practices, and events for high school students. Activities may resume on October 3, 2020. In-person classes will resume on Monday, October 5, 2020.

Elementary Students will still have in-person instruction and continue their education within the school building.

Middle School Students will resume in-person instruction and activities on Tuesday, September 22, 2020.

The high school students will be doing remote learning starting September 21 through October 2, 2020. Those students should check their emails and Google Classroom for work to be completed. If students need materials from the school building, they can call school and we will get the materials together for them and they can be picked up.

Siren schools are working closely with the Burnett County Department of Health and Human Services and together we are taking the steps necessary to protect the health of our students and staff.

Symptoms may develop 2-14 days after exposure, so please continue to monitor yourself.

Symptoms of COVID-19 include:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or Runny nose
- Nausea or Vomiting

Individuals who need medical care should call their medical provider to report their illness prior to seeking care at a clinic, physician's office, or hospital. Parents of students exhibiting flu-like

symptoms or staff exhibiting flu-like symptoms are asked to contact a school nurse, local health authorities or the Burnett County Department of Health.
