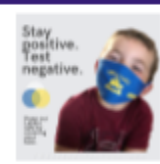

Broadband Access Speed Test

On July 14th, 2020, Governor Tony Evers signed Executive Order #80 creating the Governor's Task Force on Broadband Access. The task force will advise the Governor and Wisconsin State Legislature on broadband actions and policy, including strategies for successfully expanding high speed internet access to every residence, business, and institution in the state; initiatives for digital inclusion; and pathways to unlocking and optimizing the benefits of statewide, affordable access to broadband for all communities in Wisconsin.

In order to support this initiative, the State has created an internet speed test that can be accessed and completed by anyone in the State. We are asking all families with **home internet service** to visit this website and complete the speed test. By doing so, we can ensure that our community is well represented in this initiative and increase the likelihood of our area being included in future infrastructure improvements to support Broadband Internet Access.

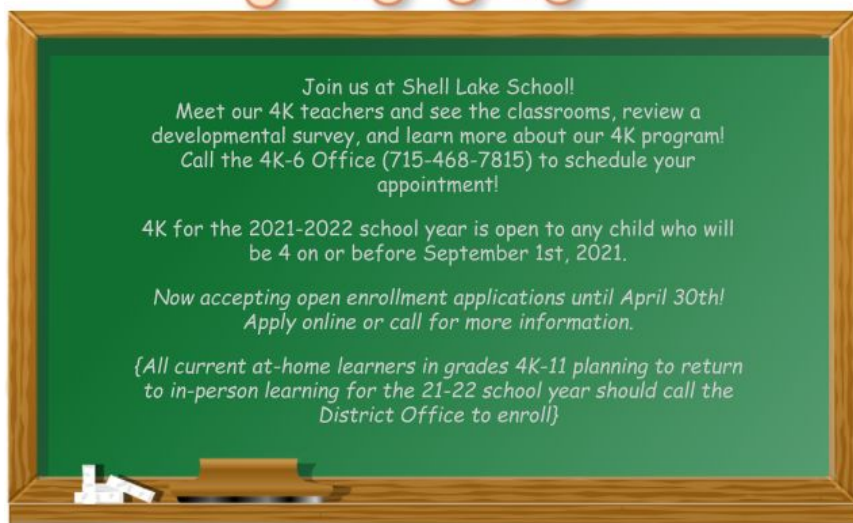


4K-6th Student of the Week is:
