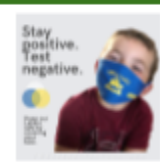

All juniors will be taking the ACT test on **Tuesday, March 9th**. All students need to report to Shell lake High School the morning of the test.

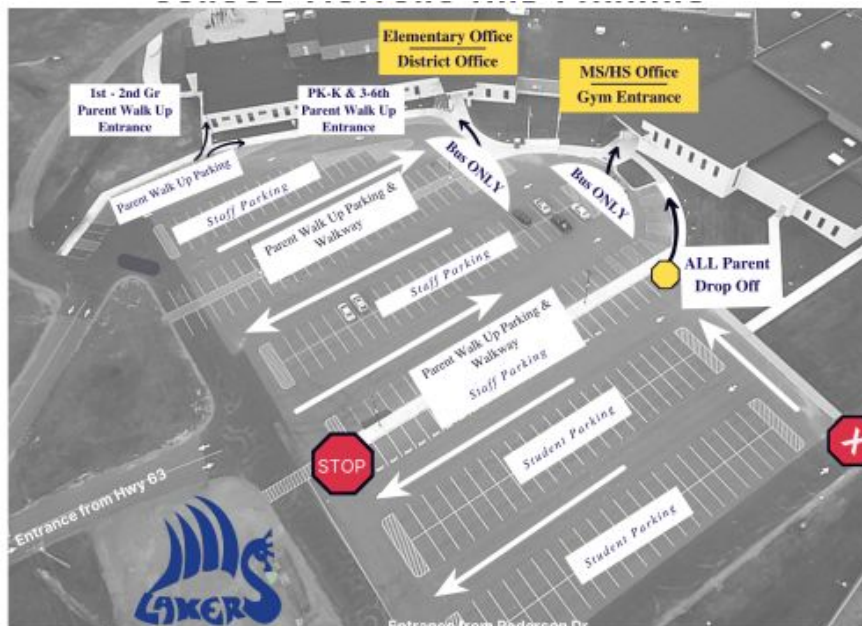

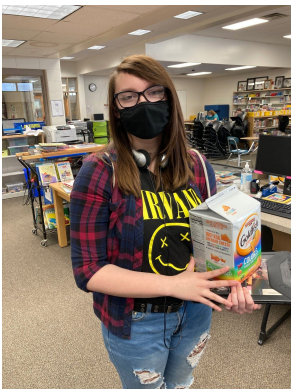

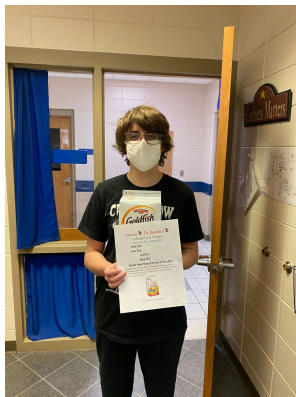


"Guess how many fish are in this dish" **School Library Challenge**
