Quick Reference Guide of Connectivity Discounts Available to Families

Ongoing	Public Service Commission Internet & Phone Helpline (608)267-3595	Speak to dedicated staff members who will help consumers connect with discount options.
Ongoing	<u>Lifeline</u>	Discounts of \$7.25 - \$18.50 on essential telecommunications.
Anticipated Start Date April 26, 2021	Emergency Broadband Benefit (Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2021)	Temporary discounts up to \$50/month (\$75 on Tribal Land) off of eligible household's internet access bill. Expires 6 months after the health emergency or when money is depleted.



Giving Mac Is for Students

K -12 students that do not already have a computer or tablet and do not have the means to purchase one are eligible to apply for the Giving Mac program. All students will have to be referred by an adult, and a written referral must accompany the student's application. The student will also have to contribute to the application process by telling our volunteer-team how they would benefit by receiving a Mac

or iPad. This can be written by an adult, but they want to hear the words of the student. Older students are encouraged to complete the essay portion of the application themselves. Giving Mac must receive both the <u>Referral Form</u> and the <u>Student's Application</u>.
