### EMERGENCY BROADBAND BENEFIT

HELPING HOUSEHOLDS CONNECT DURING THE PANDEMIC

Beginning **May 12, 2021** eligible households will be able to apply for the [Emergency Broadband Benefit Program](#), a new program from the Federal Communications Commission to assist low-income Americans who have struggled to access the internet throughout the pandemic. In order to be eligible, one individual in the household must meet at least one of the federal eligibility requirements:

Applicants are encouraged to contact their provider directly to apply as providers will have the most accurate enrollment information for applicants.
