Welcome Back Shell Lake Families!

First Day is Wednesday Sept 1st

A few changes to be aware of this year regarding drop off and pick up

- Parents are only allowed to walk their children to the classroom on the first day of school.
- The building is not open until 7:45 for students.
- We are not having morning recess this year and classrooms are not open until 8 am, so if students absolutely need to be here early (7:45), they will be sitting quietly in the commons until breakfast opens.



Breakfast

- Free breakfast is served again this year from 7:55 8:10.
- 1st 6th grade students will be eating in their classrooms this year.

Parent Pick Up:

- ALL Parent Pick Up MUST WAIT UNTIL AFTER BUSES LEAVE for safety reasons!
- Students in grades 4K-3 will be waiting in the commons to be signed out by parents at 3:30.
- No parents will be allowed into the building until busses have left the parking lot.
- Students in grades 4-6 can be picked up outside by driving through the student parking lot similar to last year.
- Families with students in grades 4-6 AND the lower grades (4K-3) will wait together in the commons for pick up.
