New Curriculum English Language Arts

Welcome back to school families,

This year, one thing that has teachers excited is our new English Language Arts curriculum, called CKLA - Core Knowledge Language Arts. This program was developed by Amplify, which is also the publisher that developed our new science curriculum.

CKLA is developed to create rich learning experiences for children in a way that builds their background knowledge of the world. So, the reading lessons are full of history, geography, science and more. Your student may come home talking about ancient Egypt or how organisms decompose as they incorporate rich vocabulary into their literacy learning. CKLA is based heavily upon the research behind the science of reading and it incorporates explicit systematic instruction in phonics and writing. Students in grades 4K-2 have a block of time for core knowledge in addition to a block of time for skill development. Research shows us that these instructional strategies can bridge learning gaps for all students and raise overall literacy for our district.
