- Little to no snow expected across NE MN

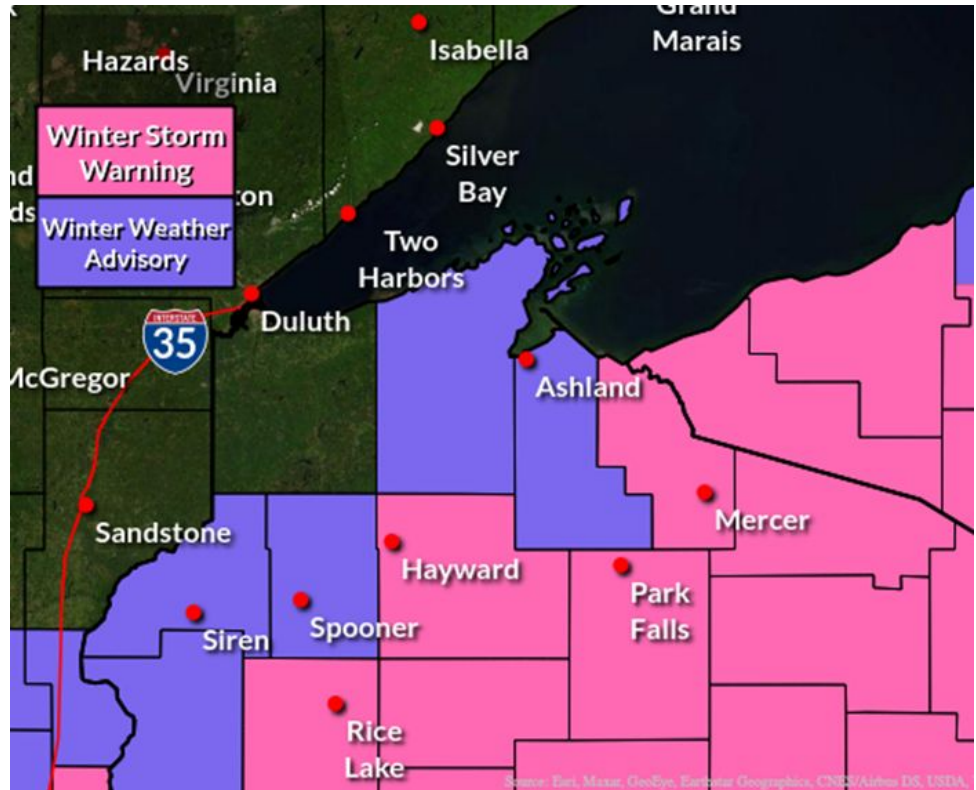

Forecast Snowfall Amounts

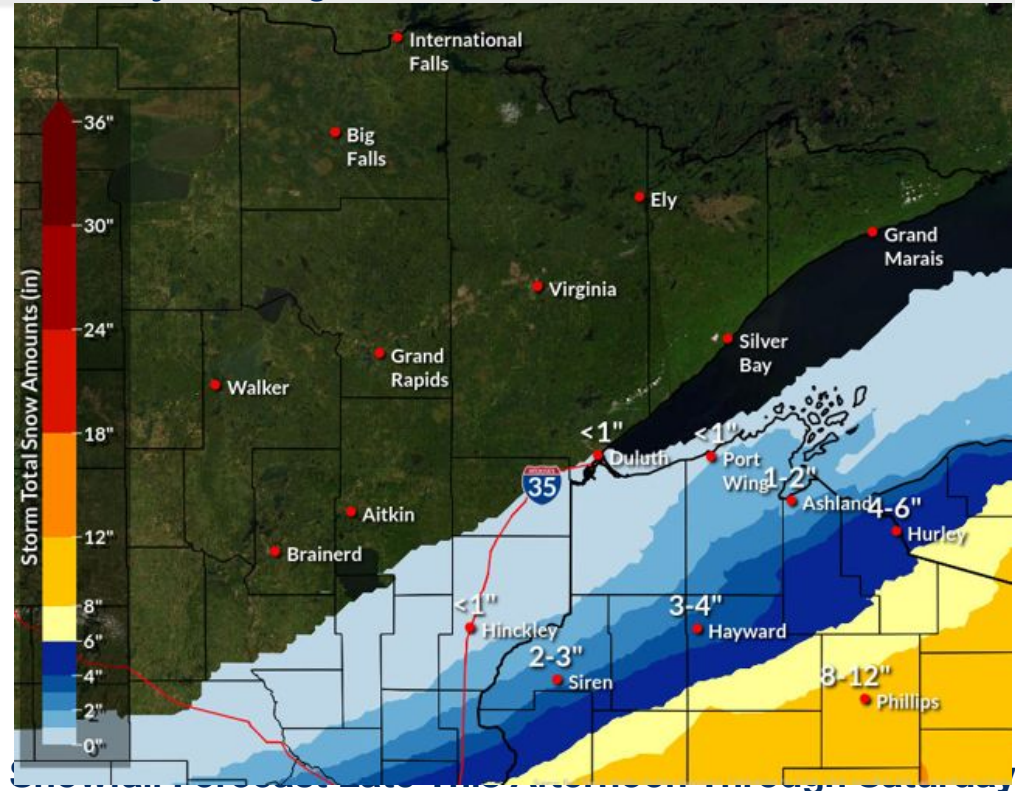

Latest Snowfall Amounts Through Saturday Morning

Details

- Snow begins late this afternoon and will become heavy this evening across Price, southeastern Sawyer and southern Iron counties
- Snow will diminish during the early morning hours with most ending by sunrise Saturday morning

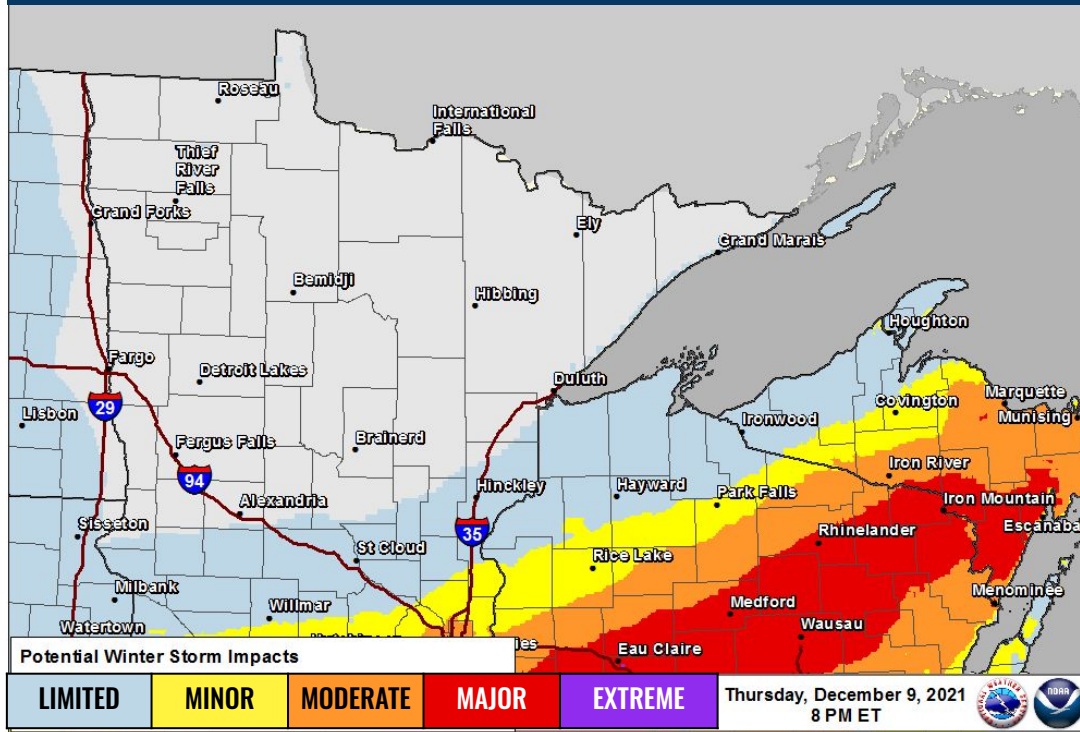
Minor to Moderate Impacts Across Part of Northwest Wisconsin



Impact Details

- Snow covered roads tonight into Saturday across northwest Wisconsin
- Some blowing snow possible Saturday, mainly across Price County

Winter Storm Severity Index



Certainty/Confidence:

- Confidence is high that much of NE Minnesota will see little to no snow from this event
- Confidence in snowfall amounts across NW Wisconsin is fairly high, especially in where the highest amounts will occur

Ice and Snow, Take it Slow

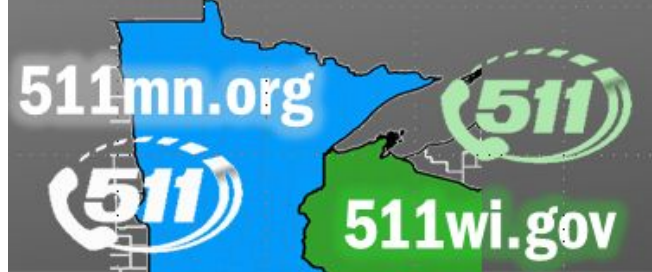
70% of snow and ice-related injuries occur in automobiles
