Authoritative Parenting (vs. authoritarian or permissive)

Parenting styles can fit into any one of the categories above. Parents who offer lots of warmth, nurturing and support but with very little discipline, low expectations and minimal limits are permissive. Permissive parents are not giving their children high enough expectations or the limits that children crave. There is security for children in knowing that there is someone who is in charge and life doesn't revolve around their desires and wishes. On the other hand, parents who have very strong limits and discipline without encouragement or support are called authoritarian. Authoritarian parents may use controlling methods to exact behaviors out of children and limit their children's ability to make decisions on their own. It's easy for us as parents to swing between being too permissive when we don't want to hurt our children's feelings or towards being overly authoritarian when they are disrespectful and disobedient. However, the most effective parenting style is to be authoritarian or as I call it, a warm demander. Parents can be caring, warm and supportive but also expect respect from their children and create clear boundaries for behaviors. Consistent and calm discipline gives children a sense of security - they know what to expect and they also have the strong foundation of parental love and support to be able to meet those expectations
