Winter Health Reminders

With this weather comes sickness (influenza, RSV, common colds, etc.) Please remember to keep your student home if they have the following symptoms:

- Fever of 100.4 or greater
- Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Persistent Cough
- Overall not feeling well enough to be in school
- *Students need to be fever free for 24 hours without use of medication before returning to school. Students also need to be vomiting and diarrhea free for 24 hours before returning.*



Encourage drinking plenty of water, getting the proper sleep, and washing hands to prevent sickness.
