- **Dangerous Wind Chills**




 Winter Storm Watch expanded to include southern Cass and Crow Wing counties

Prolonged High Winds

Peak Gusts Through Saturday

- → What: North to northwest gusts around 45 mph. Higher gusts are forecast near Lake Superior.
- → Timing: Winds will significantly increase
 Thursday morning and remain strong through
 at least Saturday
- Trees that remain snow-loaded from the previous storm combined with strong winds are a concern for additional tree damage and power outages.
- → Significantly reduced visibility in blowing snow. Blizzard conditions possible!


Snowfall Probabilities

Wednesday through Saturday Morning


Details

- Snow is forecast to begin to overspread northeast Minnesota and northwest Wisconsin through the day on Wednesday.
- Snow may continue, especially for the snow belt in northwest Wisconsin through Saturday.

Dangerous Wind Chills

- → Dangerous wind chills begin tonight (as low as -30 F) with a short warm-up on Wednesday
- → Dangerous wind chills of -25 to -30 return Thursday night and continue through Christmas Eve on Saturday
- → Frostbite in 30 minutes or less is possible to exposed skin

Wind Chill is the air temperature equivalent in calm wind which would result in heat loss equal to the temperature and wind together. Body heat loss can cause frostbite and/or hypothermia.
