## **PK-6 Laker of the Week**



#### **Vocabulary Acquisition**

By around the age of 2, children are babbling about everything they see as they explore their world. At kindergarten, children have around 1,000-2,000 words in their vocabulary but by 3rd grade they know around 15,000 words, and by 6th grade their vocabulary jumps up to 25,000. Much of this vocabulary is gained through experiences and conversations with adults. The best way to help children learn is through one-on-one discourse with an adult. If there are multiple children in the home and schedules are packed with activities, it can be challenging to find one-on-one time with each child, but I would encourage you to try to make it a priority. Even just a 5-10 minute conversation helps kids grow in their abilities to listen, answer questions and respond with deeper thinking. We are creating an opportunity for you to help grow your child's vocabulary with a word of the week. This week our word was challenge and we found lots of ways to toss that word into our everyday conversations with kids. Keep your eyes out for the word of the week so you can join in on the challenge with us! March 12th-18th→
