Parents,

Our kids spend as much as 5 hours a day on screens which means that internet safety and protocols should be a top priority. There are a few different things parents should consider when developing parameters and expectations around technology in the home.

1. Protection of personal information: Children should know to create good passwords and to never give out personal information online.
2. Content filtering: Talk to your phone provider about how to set up content filters or limit the sites/apps you allow to protect young minds from the vast array of content available on the world wide web.
3. Limit the use of unsupervised technology: more screen time impacts social skills, sleep, and academic engagement.

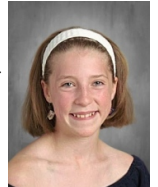
