Love and Logic

Many of our teachers have received training through the Love and Logic program (by Jim Fay). There is also parenting training with resources to help with difficult behaviors at home. Love and Logic is based upon these key principles:

- 1. Enhance self-concept the confidence of being loved by the important people in their life, a sense of capability, and more emphasis on strengths than weaknesses
- 2. Share the control (provide children choices within your limits). Jim Fay suggests that instead of intimidating children into cooperating with adults, it's better to find ways to build up cooperation. Children want to have a sense of autonomy and need to know they have choices.
- 3. Consequences with Empathy One of my favorite Love and Logic statements is "Oh that's a bummer." When children go outside of the limits, their consequences need to be a logical natural consequence but we can still empathize with them about their disappointment.


