

Kids 4-10 and their parents are invited to learn about bees and beekeepers, how they are heroes, and what others can do to help them on Tuesday, July 18 at 2pm with Beekeeper Val Haack from Shell Lake. Listen to stories with Val, enjoy a question and answer time, and make a fun craft!

A beekeeper is a person who keeps **honey bees**. Honey bees produce **honey**, **beeswax**, **propolis**, and royal jelly. Bees have 5 eyes and 6 legs and harvest nectar and pollen from flowering plants. Male bees in the hive are called drones and they do not have a stinger. Worker bees are females. They do all the different tasks needed to operate and maintain the hive. Honey bees live in large groups called colonies. An average beehive can hold around 50,000 bees.
