- 5. Now you may scroll down in the open window to see the available times for your child's teacher.
- 6. Click "select time" for the time slot you wish to choose.
- 7. View and confirm the correct time. Click "Save"
- 8. When finished, you may click "Print All Scheduled Conferences" to print a copy of your scheduled conference(s).
- 9. You will receive an email confirmation if you have an email on file with the school district.
