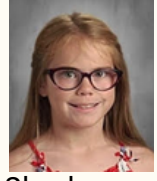

## Substitute Teacher Training

FACE-TO-FACE

APRIL 10 & 11, 2024 | 8:00 AM - 3:30 PM | CESA #11

Both days are required

Anyone who holds an associate degree or higher from an accredited college or university has the opportunity to attend a two-part training to earn a three year WI Substitute Teacher License. This training will take place at the CESA #11 office in Turtle Lake. (A small amount of homework will need to be completed and turned in to the instructor before receiving your certificate of completion for the training.) This training will also include access to Foundations of Effective Substitute Teacher Training Master Teacher Online Courses.

### Training Topics include:

- Basic district and school policies and procedures
- Age appropriate teaching strategies
- Discipline, conflict resolution, and classroom management techniques
- Health and safety issues including handling medical emergencies
- Techniques for starting a class
- The culture of schools and the profession
- Working with lesson plans
- Educational technology use
- Working with children with special needs, including confidentiality issues
- Substitute teacher license application process
