The food pantry is available to any family who have students within the Shell Lake School District.



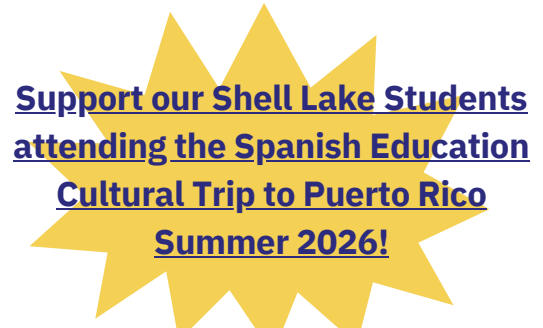
Shell Lake 4K Registration
