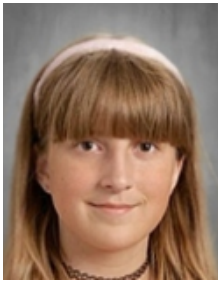

SHELL LAKE STUDENTS OF THE WEEK

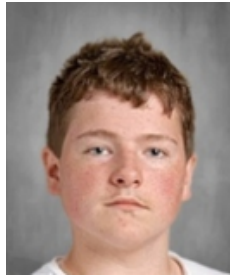

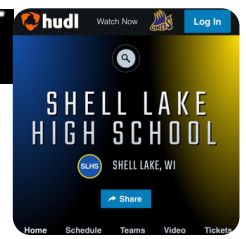
