





Storm Total Accumulations (Today through Friday)








Coastal Flooding & Damage Likely



- Waves of 16-20 feet will crash on the shores of Lake Superior, which could produce flooding and damage along the lake shore
- Stay off break walls and other shoreline structures or you could be swept away or hit by lofted chunks of ice!

Potent Spring Snow Storm Today/Tonight/Friday

Winter Driving Safety
